



## JESUS' BAPTISM


Read: Orthodox Children's Bible Reader page 178

"We see the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove above Jesus' head. The Holy Trinity is the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Do you see St. John the Baptist in the icon? What is the name of this river?









#### NARRATE BACK TO ME

As we have the kids tell the story back to us, they learn to organize the events that took place, the sequence, and many of the details. Then they have to articulate it out loud. Have you ever told someone, "I know what I want to say, I just don't know how to put it into words." Summarizing the story back to the teacher helps the child: 1) Remember the story and store it in long term memory 2) Learn to articulate their thoughts into words (This is something we learn through practice.)

File Folder Activity

We have now learned about the Annunciation, Nativity of Christ, the Presentation of Christ into the Temple, and the Baptism of Christ.

Another name for the feast day of the Baptism of Christ is Theophany.

Remove the icons of the Annunciation, Nativity of Christ, the Presentation of Christ into the Temple, and the Baptism of Christ before class. When it's time for the activity, ask, "Please find the icon of the Annunciation. Now find the icon of the Nativity of Christ...Now place them in the correct pocket. I'll come around the room and help you."
