

Goals for the Year

- Review and learn more about the Bible and Holy Tradition
- Encourage parents to read the Gospel of Matthew, along with other stories of the Bible, regularly with their family
- Prepare and encourage children to have weekly Sunday
 discussions with their parents about each week's topic during the
 car ride home

St. John Chrysostom teaches us in An Address on Vainglory e3 the Right Way for Parents to Bring Up Their Children:

- 1. Tell our children a story from the Bible
- 2. Then retell the same story to your child, until they know the story well
- 3. Ask your child to narrate the story back to you
- 4. Explain the story and how it benefits them
- 5. "This is not all. Go, leading him by the hand in church and pay heed particularly when this tale is read aloud. Thou wilt see him rejoice and leap with pleasure because he knows what the other children do not know, as he anticipates the story, recognizes it, and derives great gain from it. And hereafter the episode is fixed in his memory."

For children in grades 2 and younger, we will be predominately using the Orthodox Children's Bible. We will also be supplementing with stories about the saints of the Bible from Potamitis Publishing and 101 Orthodox Saints from Ancient Faith Publishing.
